What do you learn about Jesus? How does Jesus' life impact yours?

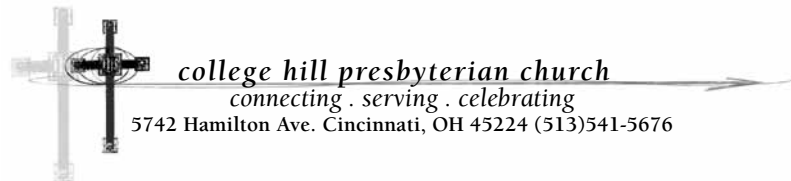
