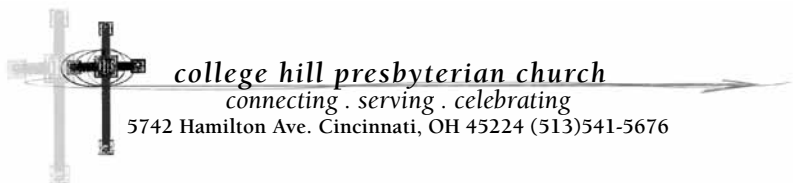
Adult Sunday School Will Not Meet on Aug. 8.
